





The Biography of Mahinur Jahid

MAHINUR JAHID was born on June 15, 1984 in Comilla, Bangladesh, and was raised in a middle class family with four siblings—two brothers and two sisters.

At sixteen years of age while attending high school in Dhaka, Bangladesh, he and his brother Tanvir moved to Spain to visit his seriously ill father journalist Delwar Jahid, who was in exile since 1995.

In 2000 he started his technical studies under The Martin Sarmiento Technical College of Pontevedra, Spain. In addition he supported his family working in a part time position.

Mahinur was a dedicated youth who devoted himself for the family and parents. He was beloved by all the people around him. After completion of his studies in Spain in 2005 he moved again, this time to Winnipeg in Canada. There he studied at The Louis Riel Arts & Technology Centre of Winnipeg for about 2 years and then moved to Calgary, where he took part in an Automotive Course of Motive Action.

After successful completion of that course he was working fulltime in Lloydminster, living with his parents, and newly married spouse Rayhana Rasmin.

In January 4, 2012 he died in a car accident in Lloydminster.

Mahinur always believed that individual commitment for a group effort -- that is what makes a team work, a company work, a society work, a civilization work.

Seminar on Safety and Accident Prevention

The seminar was held in Mahinur's birth place Comilla in Bangladesh on April 13, 2012 and served as a first program of the Mahinur Jahid Memorial Foundation (MJMF).

Bahauddin Bahar MP was present in the seminar as chief guest, while a keynote paper of journalist Delwar Jahid was presented.
